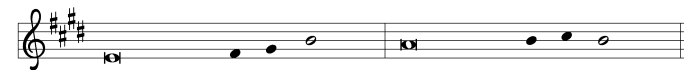

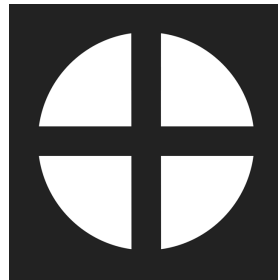

He was able to turn his second walk into a run when the three batters following him were able to advance him through hits or walks. In the field Christian played left field and had two bloopers hit to him which he fielded cleanly.
