Parts of the Church

Narthex The entry into the church. The area
of the church where people greet
each other and visit.

Sanctuary A large area of the church where
people gather together to worship.
The sanctuary is a special place and
we need to respect it.

Baptismal Font Located in the front of the church.
A person is baptized and becomes a
part of God's family.

- Altar** The table in the Sanctuary where the Lord's Supper (Holy Communion) is served.
- Communion Rail** The place in the Sanctuary where people gather around the table and share the Lord's Supper.

The curriculum and memory work are designed to provide students with knowledge needed for confirmation. Christian education plays an important role for children to know God and God's love. 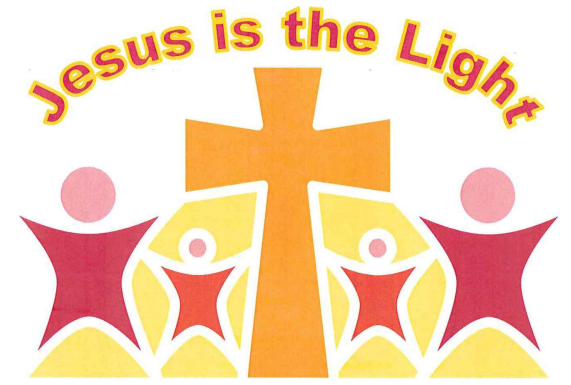
