We confess that we hurt other people with what we say and what we do. Loving God, forgive us.



"Here is Bread"

ELW 483 (Verse 1)

Here is bread, here is wine, Christ is with us, he is with us. Break the bread, taste the wine, Christ is with us here. In this bread there is healing, in this cup is life forever. In this moment, by the Spirit, Christ is with us here. Now that the table is set, we need to hear the story of this holy meal of communion and promise:

In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying: Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me.

Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink, saying: This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this for the remembrance of me.

Lord's Prayer

Before we can eat and drink the Lord's Supper, like we do for all of our meals we first need to pray. So let us pray the prayer that Jesus taught us:

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Save us from the time of trial and deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and forever. Amen.




Communion Blessing and Prayer
