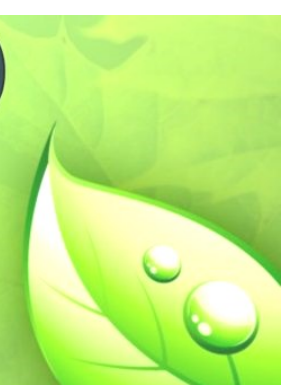

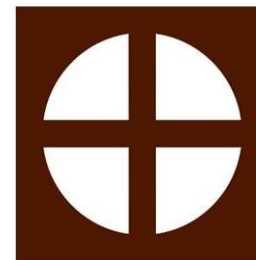


FAIR TRADE MARKET
