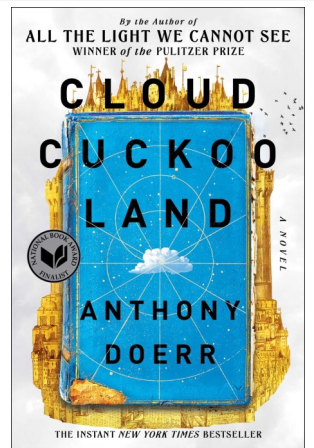

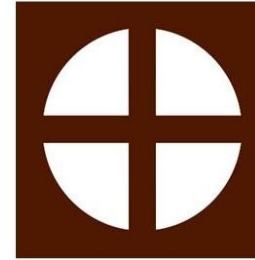

COFFEE FELLOWSHIP

With fall comes new worship opportunities . . . our traditional service at 9:00, coffee fellowship, Worshiping Arts from 10:10 to 10:35 and our 2nd worship service. Parish Fellowship is looking for volunteers to set up coffee before the 1st worship service for members to enjoy after the 1st service has ended. We're trying something new in that we'll be serving coffee through the kitchen doors that open up into the hallway between the kitchen and fellowship hall. This will make it much easier than loading everything onto the carts and bringing it in to the fellowship hall! Cleanup, as well, will then be a little more streamlined. Below is a checklist to make your (once in a while!) Sunday commitment run smoothly!

- Make 20 cups of regular coffee in electric coffeemaker, set drip catcher cups under spigot, label "coffee". Coffee and directions for making it are in the cabinets on the west wall of the kitchen
- Make 15 cups of decaf coffee in another electric coffeemaker, set drip catcher cups under spigot, label "decaf coffee"
- Heat 20 cups of water in a third coffeemaker, set drip catcher cups under spigot, label "hot water" you'll find these labels in the cupboard that houses the coffeemakers in the back part of the kitchen (left side of tall cupboard as you enter the back part of the kitchen)
- Set out creamer, sugar and sugar substitute found in the cupboard just to the right of the sink
- Set out tea bags
- Set out foam insulated cups
- Set out treats if you decide to serve them. You may provide home-made, or purchase commercially. We do have a budget line item for coffee treats, simply submit the receipt to our treasurer for reimbursement.
- (About 3 dozen cookies or so, or a pan of bars cut small is plenty to serve)
