# **Continuing Business**

- 1. Long term Rental/Lease agreements Where are we on this? No update
- **2. Custodian is back this week.** We should send thank you's to the people that stepped up to clean the weeks Bryant was out.
  - Tammy and Bob sent some. Emily Block will send the rest.
- **3. Congregational discussion on Sunday September 17**<sup>th</sup>, leadership met on Sunday October 1<sup>st</sup> to go over the discussion and begin to ask for task force members
- **4.** Last month we voted to increase Pastor Nikki's position from 1/2 time to 3/4 time. However, things have changed and we need to change this plan.
- 5. Legacy Partnership Foundation plan for early next year Hold until next year

#### New Business Agenda Items – Pastors Ben and Nikki and Leadership Team:

**1. Fair Trade weekend** Over \$18,000 in sales. One vendor didn't come and the big baskets didn't sell, so total sales were down a little.

#### **2. OSLC Future Direction task force???**

- a) Membership: Pastor Ben, Bob Westland, Emily Blain, Joanne Heathman, Melissa Psomas. Need one more person. A few possibilities were floated, and there are council members who will ask them.
- **3. Stewardship Appeal letter has been printed and needs to be mailed out.** Joanne is out Tuesday and Wednesday. Does leadership need to handle?
  - Tammy did a number of them, there are still some left to do.
- **4. Pastor Nikki's position change**, goes back to ½ time, **but 60% Good Shepherd 40% Our Savior's.** This will reduce things Pastor Nikki was planning on doing. So we need members to step up.
  - Pastor Nikki will be working 80 hours a month. Priorities will focus on "must do's": prep worship, sermon, meetings, and youth.
  - Joint Lay Ministry every other month. Visits will be for those who are sick or hospitalized, not for those who are homebound. Lay Ministry team also does visitation.
  - Family Sunday school Done through December. Need a point person. Katie Holger agreed to be the point person. Emily Blain can help as well.
  - Fully lead joint youth team. Individual churches will handle their own activities.
  - Will be at OSLC one Sunday a month and preaching that Sunday.
  - Carole Joyce arranging Christmas party and another event.
  - Bob asked for motion. Tim motioned to approve the change. Tammy seconded. Passed by unanimous vote.
  - \*\*\* Note: After the meeting we learned Good Shepherd's council approved the reduction to 1/2 time, but did not approve the switch to 60% instead of 40%. Pastor Nikki will remain 60% at OSLC and 40% at Good Shepherd.

### 5. Christmas Eve Worship Schedule

• Cross pollinate services with Good Shepherd. OSLC services will be at 4pm and 10pm. Good Shepherd's will be at 4pm and 8pm.

### 6. Offerings designations for midweek Advent and Thanksgiving Eve services

- Thanksgiving Eve OSLC will have a worship service with offering. Good Shepherd will come here for service. Pie fellowship after service is a fundraiser for youth gathering.
- Advent and Thanksgiving Eve services offerings will go proportionally to local benevolence groups: Samaritan Bethany, Good Earth Village, and Rainbow School.

# 7. \$14,000 gift

• Will be used to pay for 3 last months of mortgage in 2023 and the remaining amount (about \$4,000) will go to reduce the principal.

## 8. Preliminary budget discussion.

- a) Emily, Emily, Tim and Bob meet to start looking at this.
  - Joanne will not go to 1/2 time. She might be willing to be creative with benefits and not get retirement contributions.
- b) Medical benefits for Portico.
  - Emily Blain motioned to keep the benefits the same (Gold Plus). Tim seconded. Jennie abstained. Passed by unanimous vote.
- c) Suspend benevolence payments until December.
  - Payments to be decided at that time.
