Treasurer's Report (Emily Block)

Income YTD (as of 03/31/2024): \$128,574.51 Expenses YTD (as of 03/31/2024): \$117,311.96

Budgeted Expenses: \$105,873.75

Insurance went up by 50% with no claims. Did some checking around. Asked another independent agent to look at it and give a quote.

Stewardship & Required Minimum Distributions - make people aware of RMDs in a Weekly article and during the annual stewardship drive.

Continuing Business

- 1. **Future Church Taskforce/Evangelism Team any updates/requests?** The task force agreed to become the Evangelism Team. They are meeting monthly.
- 2. Staff annual reviews
 - a) As Senior Pastor, Pastor Ben will handle with staff. Will happen in May.
 - b) Personnel team will review Pastor Ben. Will happen in May.
- 3. **Long term Rental/Lease agreements** Emily Blain meeting with Carolyn on April 16. Decided to hold off on creating a generic form until someone else requests a long term rental.
- 4. Taco Jed with Good Shepherd Leadership team Casual gathering on Sunday, April 14 at 6pm.
- 5. **Still need a VP** Discussed possibilities. Pastor Ben will make some phone calls.

New Business Agenda Items

1. **Discuss having Emily's friends come do an accessibility audit**. They will come during the service and determine what was easy and what was hard. They will present their findings immediately after the service. Funding is covered. Identified Sundays in April and May that would work. Emily will reach out and see if they are available on one of those Sundays.

2. Summer pastoral coverage

- a) Both pastors will be gone on June 16 and July 28. July 7 & 21 joint services with Good Shepherd. July 21 Pastor Nikki and Paster Carl-Eric will be on the youth trip.
- b) Will utilize pulpit supply for the two Sundays, which is in the budget.

 - b) Barriers
 - i. Discussed list and who can take responsibility

 - iii. Internet and wireless routers upgraded previously
 - iv. Update the website in general, including adding photos of youth
 - v. Looking at new church management software for website, which would decrease costs
