

- 2) For amounts less than \$1,000, the request will be forwarded to the Executive Committee for review/decision.
- 3) For amounts greater than or equal to \$1,000, the request will be forwarded to Leadership Council for review/decision.

Decision will be communicated to requesting congregant and approved funds will be distributed from the undesignated Memorial funds account.
