Discussed a building walk-through with Emily Blain and Dan Jordan. Discussed possible renovations that would make the building more accessible and reflect current ministry activities.

# **Continuing/New Business**

- ➤ The Redeemed Christian Church of God hosting their 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary and renting OSLC for Saturday, August 30 Award Night & Dinner, 4:00 PM. Rent was \$150.00.
  - Originally, they reserved set up time on Thursday and Friday before the event. Now they would like to extend their set up time to include multiple days earlier that week and more space. The previously signed contact was reviewed. Discussion/suggestions included:
    - Confirming a contact person (phone #/email) from both churches for any issues during the set up or the Saturday event.
    - Confirm planned use of our sound board, including someone from their church with knowledge of how to operate our equipment. If OSLC sound person is needed, additional cost of \$100 to pay for this time.
    - o Emily Blain will be the OSLC contact person for Saturday event.
    - o Pastor Ben will follow-up with these arrangements and communications.
